2 Q -- that stood out to you about Dr. Sabin's  
3 evaluation?

4 A You know, there was some inconsistency that  
5 I found. I take the notes of Dr. Wheeler, for  
6 example.

7 When you read -- and -- and it would be an  
8 interesting exercise to read those before the  
9 Court -- when you read what is in Dr. Sabin's report,  
10 what she put in her report and what are actually in  
11 those notes, there's a big differences between those.  
12 There were things that were left out. There's things  
13 that were cherry picked. And that is a -- a smoking  
14 gun for bias.

15 Q Okay. What about with respect to the  
16 counseling records?

17 A You know, the counselor -- you know, I  
18 think that that's a matter of interpretation to some  
19 degree. I think I read that. I came away with one  
20 inference around that.

21 I believe Dr. Sabin, from my understanding  
22 of e-mails that I've read -- or at least one e-mail  
23 that I read in her report, she came away from that  
24 from a different understanding.
