Summary of Probable Cause:

On 03-01-19 at 1800 hours, Elise Folk called to report a disturbance with her husband Duane Folk. Elise and Duane reside together at their residence of 41000 NE 149th Avenue. Duane left the residence prior to law enforcement arrival and I contacted Elise at the residence. I initially contacted Ashlie Folk to obtain a brief statement who told me she, her mother and her two brothers were locked in the boy's bedroom. While they were locked in the bedroom to get away from Duane and his yelling he was pushing on the door and pushed himself in the breaking the door. She ran with her brothers to the garage and in the parked vehicle in the garage. Their mother followed in the garage and Duane followed behind them. Ashlie ran out of the garage with her brothers to outside the front of the house. Her brothers ran for their grandmother's house and Ashlie stayed behind. Elise ran outside followed by Duane who then grabbed a hold of Elise's hair behind her head and pulled her to the ground then dragged her. Ashlie grabbed a stick and struck Duane while he was holding Elise until he let her go. I then contacted Elise who was crying prior to me speaking with her and she continued to cry as she retold what happened this evening. She told me she was so scared of what Duane would do and believed he would hit her and kill her and the kids this evening. She was in the basement with Ashlie and her two sons. She believed she heard knocking and went up the stairs and heard knocking on the back patio slider door. Elise went to the back door adjacent to the kitchen and observed it was Duane at the back porch. She walked back to the back slider and opened the door for him. She could tell he had been drinking because he started yelling at her and she could smell it on him. Elise explained he is strange when he drinks. Duane was yelling at her about locking him out and she explained she couldn't hear the knocking from in the basement. Elise continued to walk down the basement stairs to the entertainment room where the kids were and Duane immediately went to Ashlie's face, puffed up his chest and yelled at her she was ugly and her days were numbered. Elise believed him to mean to hurt her. Elise told the kids to go upstairs and she followed behind. The kids entered the kitchen door from the interior basement door and Ashlie was looking for the phone to call 911. As Elise was at the top of the stairs Duane grabbed her arm, but Elise was able to shake off Duane's hold of her arm and run through the door, closing and latching the top latch lock. The phone wasn't there in the kitchen so Elise told her to go upstairs and find a phone as she followed behind. Duane then pushed open the door damaging the door frame and ran up the stairs behind Elise. Elise, Ashlie and the two boys locked themselves in the bedroom with Elise and Ashlie standing against the door pushing against Duane pushing on the other side. Ashlie continued to attempt to call 911, but the residence has sporadic cell reception. Duane was able to push his way in the bedroom damaging the door and continued to push against the door with Elise and Ashlie on the other side pushing them against a dresser. Duane grabs a hold of one of his boys holding him tight yelling at him until Elise grabs a hold of their son releasing Duane. Ashlie, her brothers, and Elise run downstairs to the garage and in a parked vehicle. Ashley is sitting in the driver seat, the boys in the back seat and Elise is not able to recall details as to what happened at the vehicle. She does remember Duane was yelling at Ashlie and trying to get in the car reaching for her. Ashlie gets out of the driver

side of the vehicle and the boys follow her out the driver side also while Duane continues to reach in the back seat of the vehicle towards Ashlie. Elise said she tried to push Duane in the vehicle so she could close the doors and keep him in there, but was not able to. She runs out of the garage because there are, "a lot" of guns kept all over in the garage and she believed he would kill her and the kids. Elise runs from the garage to outside the front of the house and tells her children to run to their grandmother's next door. As they run in that direction she runs to the side of the house where Duane grabs her hair at the base of her head and pushes her to the ground while holding her hair. He continues to pull her hair as he drags her and pulls her by her hair. Elise remembers thinking she has to get free because she isn't sure if Duane will hit her or kill her and she was so scared. Elise told me she remembered she had layers of shirts on including a sweatshirt and begins to grab to take it off while Duane is holding her hair. While he is holding her hair she gets her sweatshirt up to her neck and it begins to choke her. Duane continues to hold her hair and she is screaming trying to get free. Ashlie strikes Duane with a stick in an attempt to help Elise. Duane lets go of Elise and Elise runs down the hill to the woods near a creek where she remains. She said she was so scared to go home she was going to run towards the road to yell for help and stop any car that comes by. She told me she was so surprised the neighbors didn't call because of all her screaming and Duane's yelling. Elise said she saw lights coming down the driveway believing it to be 911. When she went to the driveway she saw it was her mother-in-law's vehicle and her sons were in the back seat, with Duane in the front passenger seat. Elise quickly grabs her sons and Duane begins to chase her around the vehicle until she is able to run in the house with her sons. Elise told me she just makes it in the house locking the door behind her before Duane reaches the front porch. At 1944 hours, I read Duane Miranda Rights from my Criminal Justice Training Commission issued card; he stated he understood and would speak with me. Duane told me he has counsel and all he had to say was he was, "I was hit three times with a fucking stick!" Duane was transported and booked in the Clark County Jail for charges of Malicious Mischief III - DV and Assault IV - DV.



SYNOPSIS

Elise Folk called to report assault by her husband Duane Folk. Elise was chased by Duane around the house. She and their three children, Preston, Landon and Ashlie locked themselves in a room to avoid him and he broke the door to enter. Everyone ran outside with Duane following behind. Elise told Ashlie, Preston and Landon, to run to their grandmother's house next door and Elise ran the opposite direction. Duane grabbed her hair at the back of her head pulling her out of a side by side SUV, pushing her to the ground then dragging her by her hair. Ashlie grabbed a stick and beat on Duane until the stick broke and she grabbed a rake and hit him with the handle. Elise, Preston, Landon and Ashlie were able to lock themselves in the house waiting for law enforcement.

Duane only stated he was hit with a stick three fucking times.

Duane was transported and booked in the Clark County Jail for Assault IV-DV and Malicious Mischief III- DV.

ELISE FOLK DOMESTIC VIOLENCE REPORT

DETAILS:

On 03-01-19 at 1800 hours, a call was received by dispatch and notes in the CAD call documented lots of screaming being heard in the background. Then a person came on the phone stating, " My dad is punching my Mom." And, " Hes dragging her around." Elise Folk then came to the phone to report there were lots of guns in the house, and he left for his mother' s house next door and there were more guns of his there. Deputy E. Cramer contacted Duane at his mother's residence of 41004 NE 149th Street; see his supplemental report for additional details.

I initially contacted Ashlie Folk to obtain a brief statement who told me she, her mother and her two brothers Preston and Landon locked themselves in Landon' s bedroom. They were locked in the bedroom to get away from Duane and his yelling as he continuously was pushing on the door. He eventually pushed himself in breaking the door and grabbed a hold of Preston telling him he loved him. ASHlie ran with her brothers to the garage and in the parked vehicle in the garage. Their mother followed them in the garage and Duane followed behind her. Ashlie ran out of the garage with her brothers to outside the front of the house. Her brothers ran for their grandmother' s house and Ashlie stayed behind. Elise ran outside followed by Duane who then grabbed a hold of Elise' s hair behind her head and pulled her to the

ground then dragged her. Ashlie grabbed a stick and struck Duane while he was holding Elise until he let her go.

Deputy S. Joachim arrived on scene and continued the interview with Ashlie; see his supplemental report for additional details. He also took photographs of the damaged doors and of Elise which I attached the photographs to this report electronically.

I then contacted Elise who was crying prior to me speaking with her and she continued to cry as she retold what happened this evening. She told me she was so scared of what Duane would do and believed he would hit her, and kill her and the kids this evening. Elise and Duane have been in a married on and off again marriage for the last 12 years and reside together at their residence of 41000 NE 149 th Avenue. Prior to law enforcement arrival Duane left the residence for his mother's house next door at 41004 NE 149 th Avenue.

Elise was in the basement with her children Ashlie, and her sons Preston and Landon. She believed she heard knocking and went up the stairs and heard knocking on the back patio slider door. Elise went to the back door adjacent to the kitchen and observed it was Duane at the back porch. She walked back to the back slider and opened the door for him. She could tell he had been drinking because he started yelling at her and she could smell it on him. Elise explained he is strange when he drinks. Duane was yelling at her about locking him out and she explained she couldn't hear the knocking from in the basement. Elise continued to walk down the basement stairs to the entertainment room where the kids were and Duane immediately went to Ashlie's face, puffed up his chest and yelled at her she was ugly and her days were numbered. Elise believed him to mean to hurt her.

Elise told the kids to go upstairs and she followed behind. The kids entered the kitchen door from the interior basement door and Ashlie was looking for the phone to call 911. As Elise was at the top of the stairs Duane grabbed her arm, but Elise was able to shake off Duane's hold of her arm and run through the door; closing and latching the top latch lock. The phone wasn't there in the kitchen so Elise told Ashlie to go upstairs and find a phone as she followed behind. Duane then pushed open the door damaging the door frame and ran up the stairs behind Elise. Elise, Ashlie and the two boys locked themselves in the bedroom with Elise and Ashlie standing against the door pushing against Duane who was pushing on the other side. Ashlie continued to attempt to call 911, but the residence has sporadic cell reception. Duane was able to push his way in the bedroom damaging the door and continued to push against the door with Elise and Ashlie on the other side pushing them against a dresser. Duane grabbed a hold of Preston holding him tight yelling at him until Elise grabbed a hold of their son releasing Duane's hold.

Ashlie, her brothers, and Elise ran downstairs to the garage and in a parked vehicle. Ashley was sitting in the driver seat, the boys in the back seat and Elise was not able to recall details as to what happened at the vehicle. She did remember Duane was yelling at Ashlie and trying to get in the car reaching for her. Ashlie got out of the driver side of the vehicle and the boys followed her out the driver side also while Duane continued to reach in the back seat of the vehicle towards Ashlie. Elise said she tried to push Duane in the vehicle so she could close the doors and keep him in there, but was not able to. She ran out of the garage because there are, "a lot" of guns kept all over in the garage and she believed he would kill her and the kids. Elise ran from the garage to outside the front of the house and tells her children to run to their grandmother's next door. As they run in that direction she runs to the side of the house where a side by side ATV was parked. Duane grabbed her hair at the base of her head and pulled her out and pushed her to the ground while holding her hair. He continued to pull her hair as he dragged her and pulled her by her hair. Elise remembered thinking she had to get free because she wasn't sure if Duane will hit her or kill her and she was so scared. Elise told me she remembered she had layers of shirts on including a sweatshirt and began to grab the bottom of her sweatshirt to take it off while Duane was holding her hair. While he was holding her hair she got her sweatshirt up to her neck and it began to choke her. Duane continued to hold her hair and she was screaming trying to get free. Ashlie struck Duane with a stick in an attempt to help Elise. Duane let go of Elise and Elise ran down the hill to the woods near a creek where she remained. She said she was so scared to go home she was going to run towards the road to yell for help and stop any car that came by. She told me she was so surprised the neighbors didn't call because of all her screaming and Duane's yelling.

Elise said she saw lights coming down the driveway believing it to be 911. When she went to the driveway she saw it was her mother-in-law's vehicle and her sons were in the back seat, with Duane in the front passenger seat. Elise quickly grabbed her sons and Duane began to chase her around the vehicle until she was able to run in the house with her sons. Elise told me she just made it in the house locking the door behind her before Duane reached the front porch. He returned to his mother's vehicle and went to their house.

Paramedics arrived to attend to Elise with the pain on the back of her head where her hair was pulled; she declined medical attention. While sitting in a chair she noticed her pants were wet from peeing in them. Elise said she must have done that sometime while Duane was chasing her because she was so scared. Elise completed a written statement and I witnessed her signature as well as Ashlie's.

Ashlie told me Duane has firearms hidden all over the house and the night before this evening Duane had his Ruger out. She said he was drunk again and he was yelling and swinging the Ruger around the house in front of everyone. Elise said he didn't point it at anyone, but he took it to the bathroom leaving the door open while he, ". . . had a movement." and set the Ruger on the counter for a bit before picking it up while sitting on the toilet waving it around again at her direction. Elise told me she was so afraid Duane would kill her and the kids with the firearms she asked for us to take them for safekeeping. She detailed he hides them all over the house and in toolboxes in the garage and in cabinets. Deputy E. Cramer and I collected the firearms for safekeeping, logging them on a Property sheet and leaving a copy of the sheet with Elise.

Prior to me clearing the residence Elise stated her vision was blurry and the back of her head hurt. Medics were requested to return and upon their arrival she stated she couldn't go with them to be checked out and was refusing medical attention again. Elise explained she needed to take care of her children. It was further explained to me Landon is autistic and needed her, and Duane scared Landon and Preston so much they were crying. Elise also said Ashlie had been in a collision earlier in the day where her vehicle was rear ended. Elise said she needed to stay home and take care of her children. She continued to tell me she is a stay at home mom and does not work. Also a year ago she was diagnosed with congestive heart failure and was due to go to the doctor for an evaluation of her heart and current prescribed medication.

At 1944 hours, I read Duane Miranda Rights from my Criminal Justice Training Commission issued card; he stated he understood and would speak with me. Duane told me he has counsel and all he had to say was he was, " I was hit three times with a fucking stick!" Deputy S. Joachim transported and booked Duane in the Clark County Jail for charges of Malicious Mischief III - DV and Assault IV - DV.

The firearms collected for safekeeping were added to this report as Safekeeping and submitted for Evidence Unit to collect. Photographs were taken of the firearms and their serial numbers prior to being sealed and submitted in evidence. Photographs of the firearms were submitted to this report electronically. The handwritten property sheets are attached to this report as orphans. Ashlie and Elise's written statements were submitted as evidence, and copies were made of the statements and attached to this report as orphan documents.

A wants and records check of the serial numbers of the firearms returned clear.

CONCLUSION:

Forward to the Domestic Violence Prosecution and the District Court for charges of Assault IV-DV and Malicious Mischief III- DV.







It should be mentioned that U1 was a larger truck type vehicle while U2 was a smaller sedan type vehicle. The size discrepancy did correlate with driver of U1's statements of having no visibility of U2 while operating U1.
